We only cover services in England.


We may want to contact you.

Immunisations and vaccinations are crucial for people with autism, learning disabilities, and other vulnerable groups for several reasons:

- **1.Higher Risk of Complications**: These individuals often have a higher risk of serious illness or complications from vaccine-preventable diseases.
- **2.Lower Immunization Rates**: People with developmental disabilities, including autism, tend to have lower vaccination rates, making them more susceptible to outbreaks.
- **3.Preventive Health**: Vaccinations help prevent the spread of infectious diseases, protecting not only the individual but also the community
- **4.Support and Accessibility**: Providing reasonable adjustments and support can make the vaccination process more comfortable and accessible for these individuals.
- Ensuring up-to-date vaccinations is a key step in promoting overall health and well-being.


