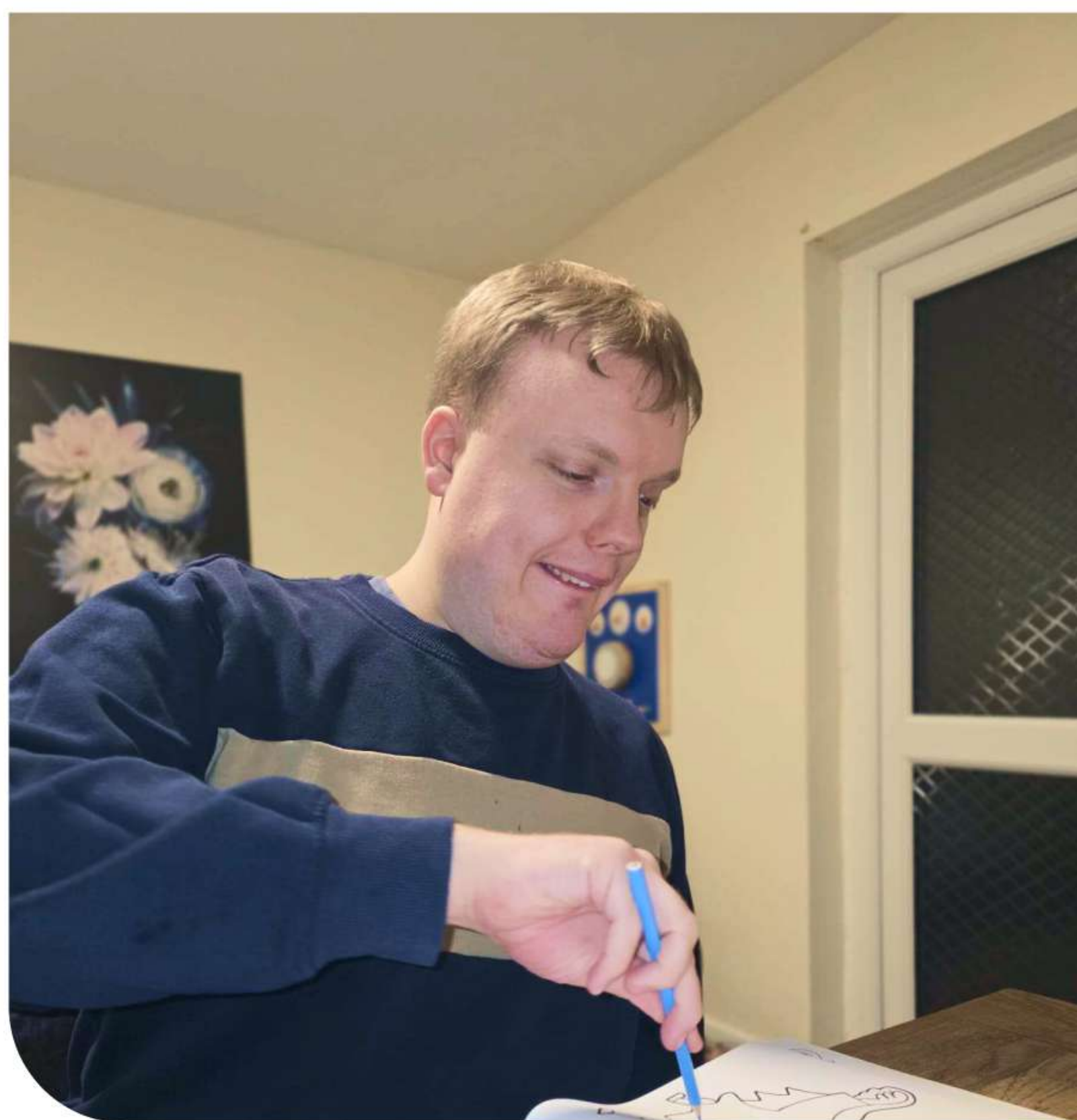

Bonfire Night Outing

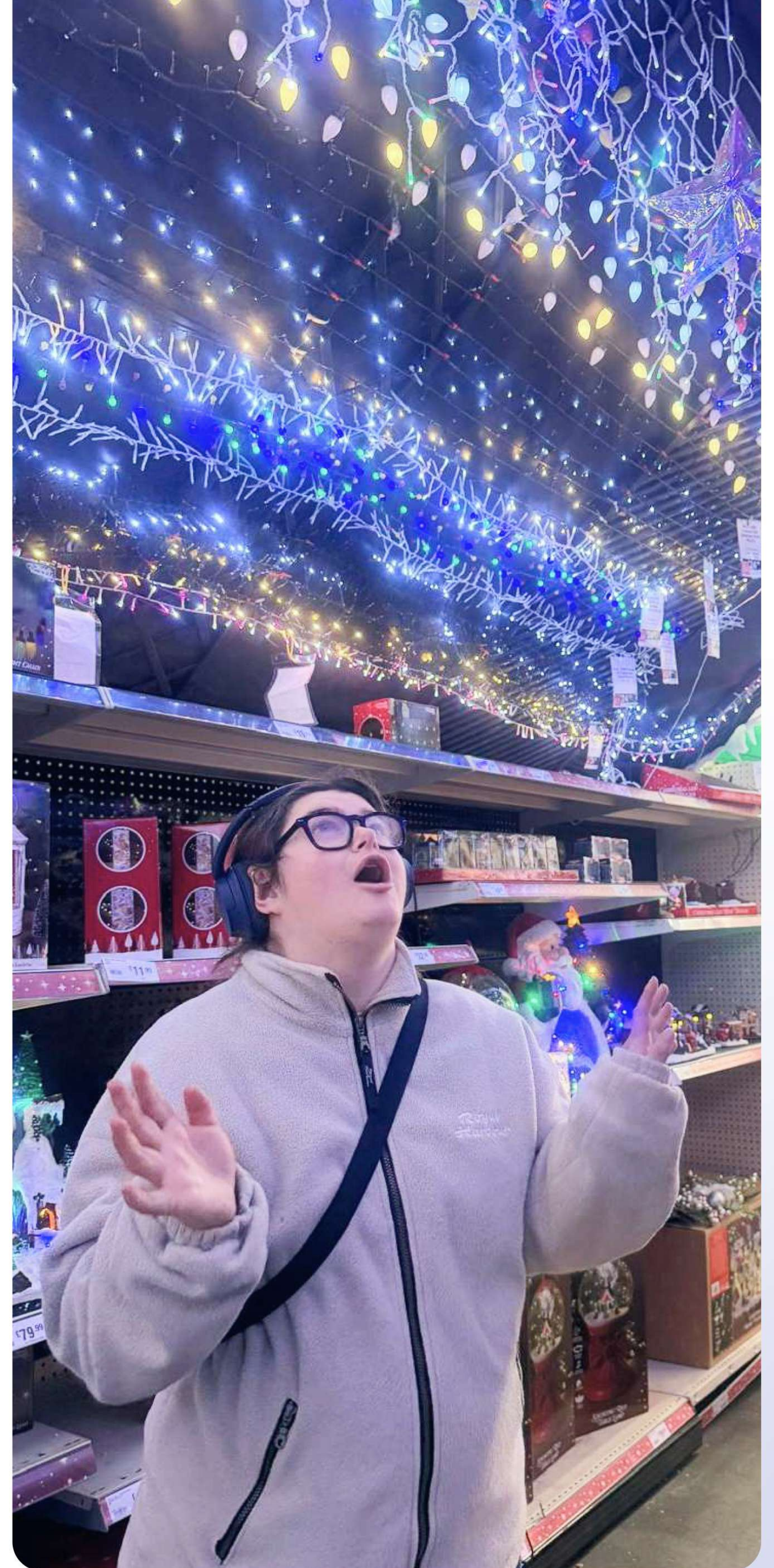
Service users enjoyed a gentle evening walk to see the bonfire and festive lights.

Calming colouring activities and music moments helped everyone unwind.



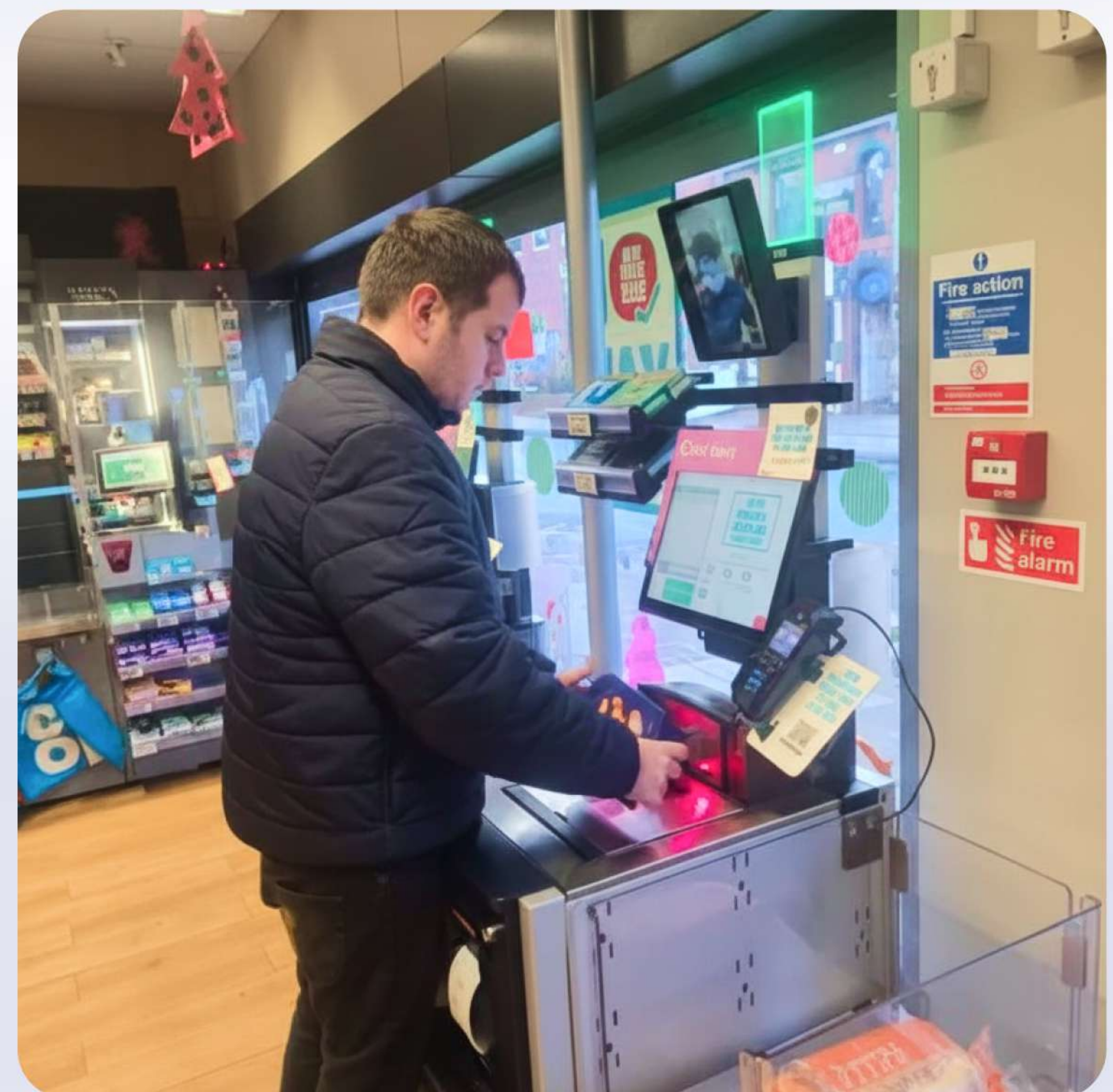
Daily Routines

REGIONAL HIGHLIGHTS: WEST MIDLANDS (STOCKWELL ROAD)

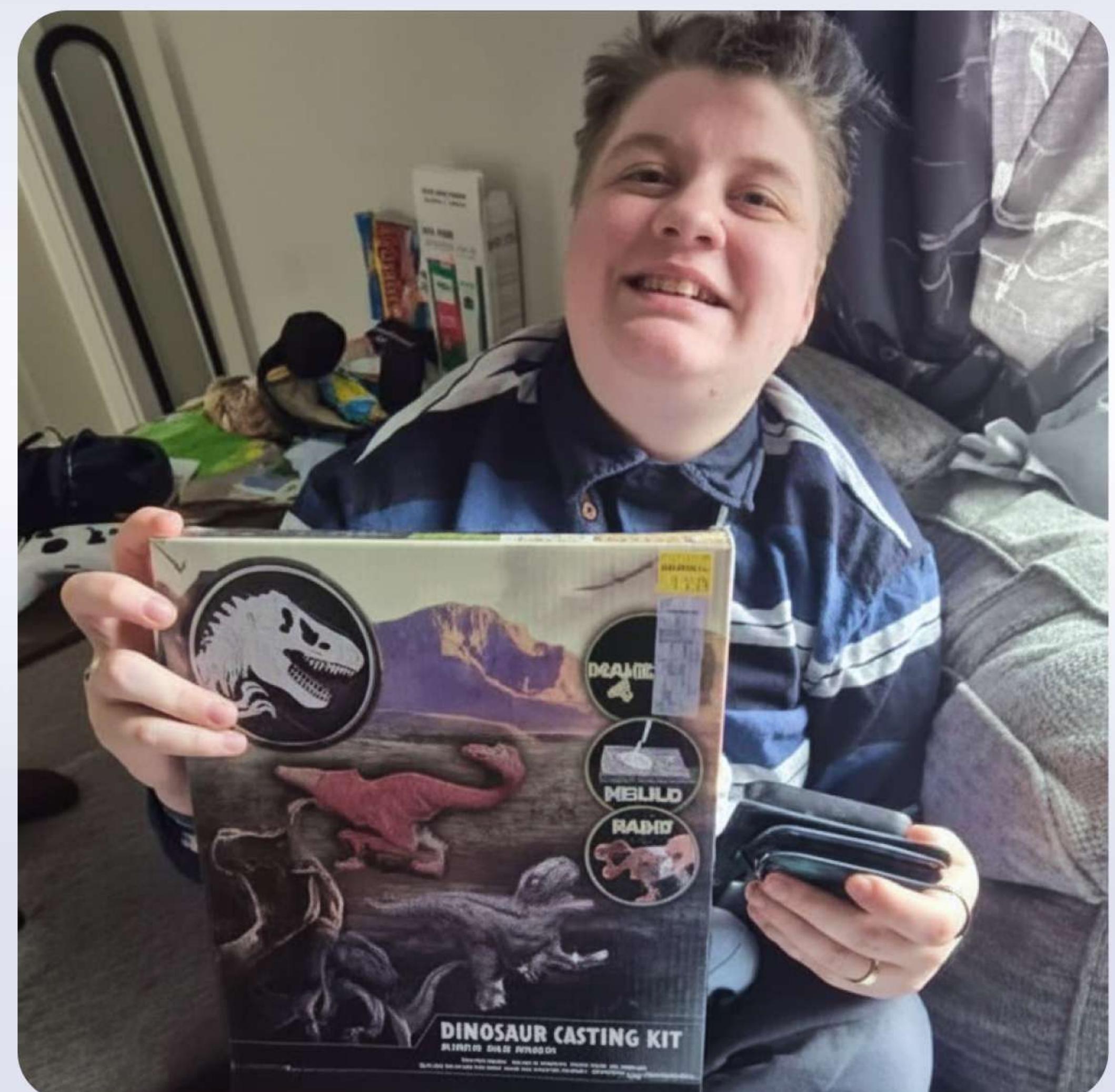
Community Walks

Gentle outings to nearby shops helped build confidence and independence.

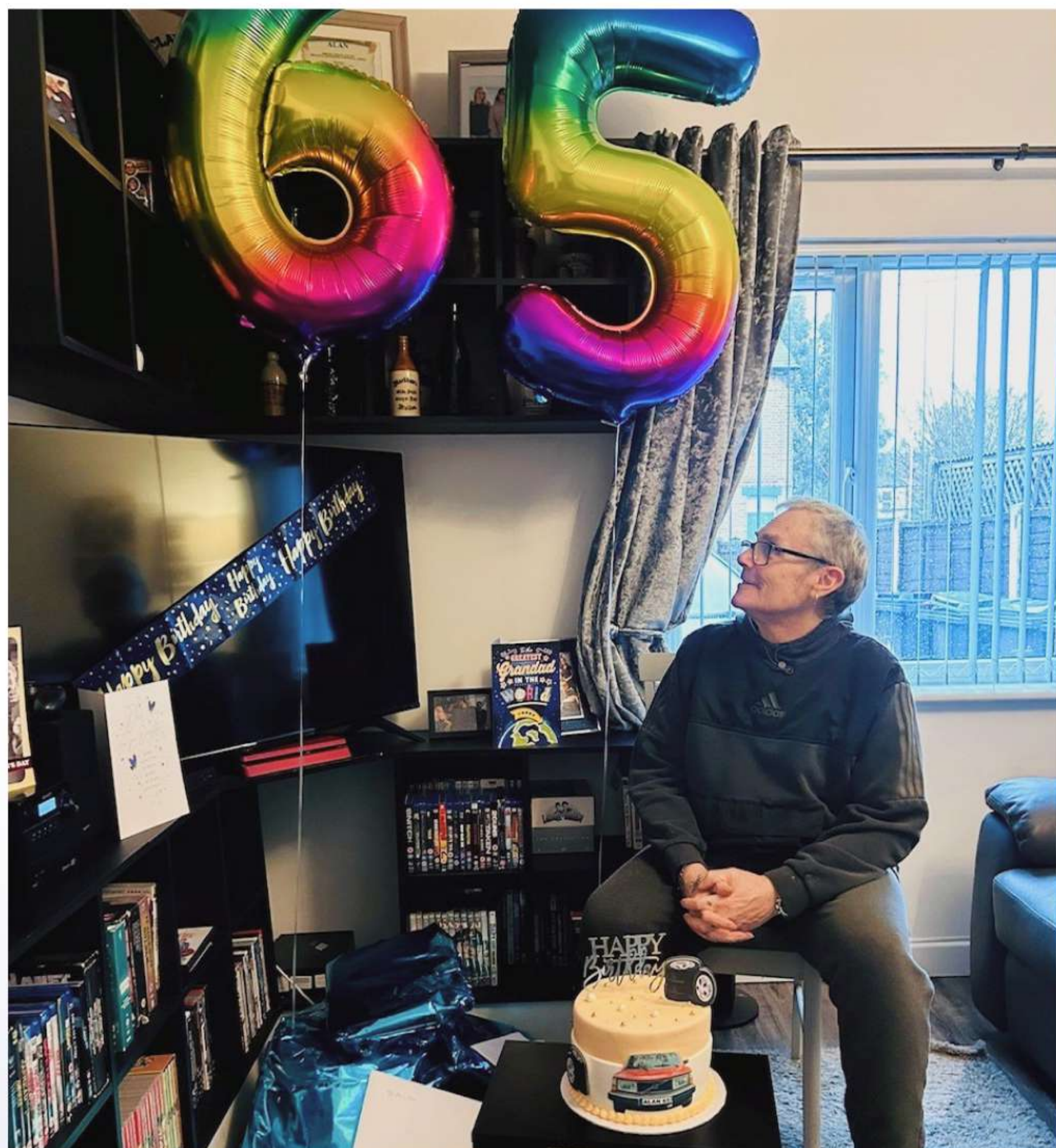


Indoor Activities

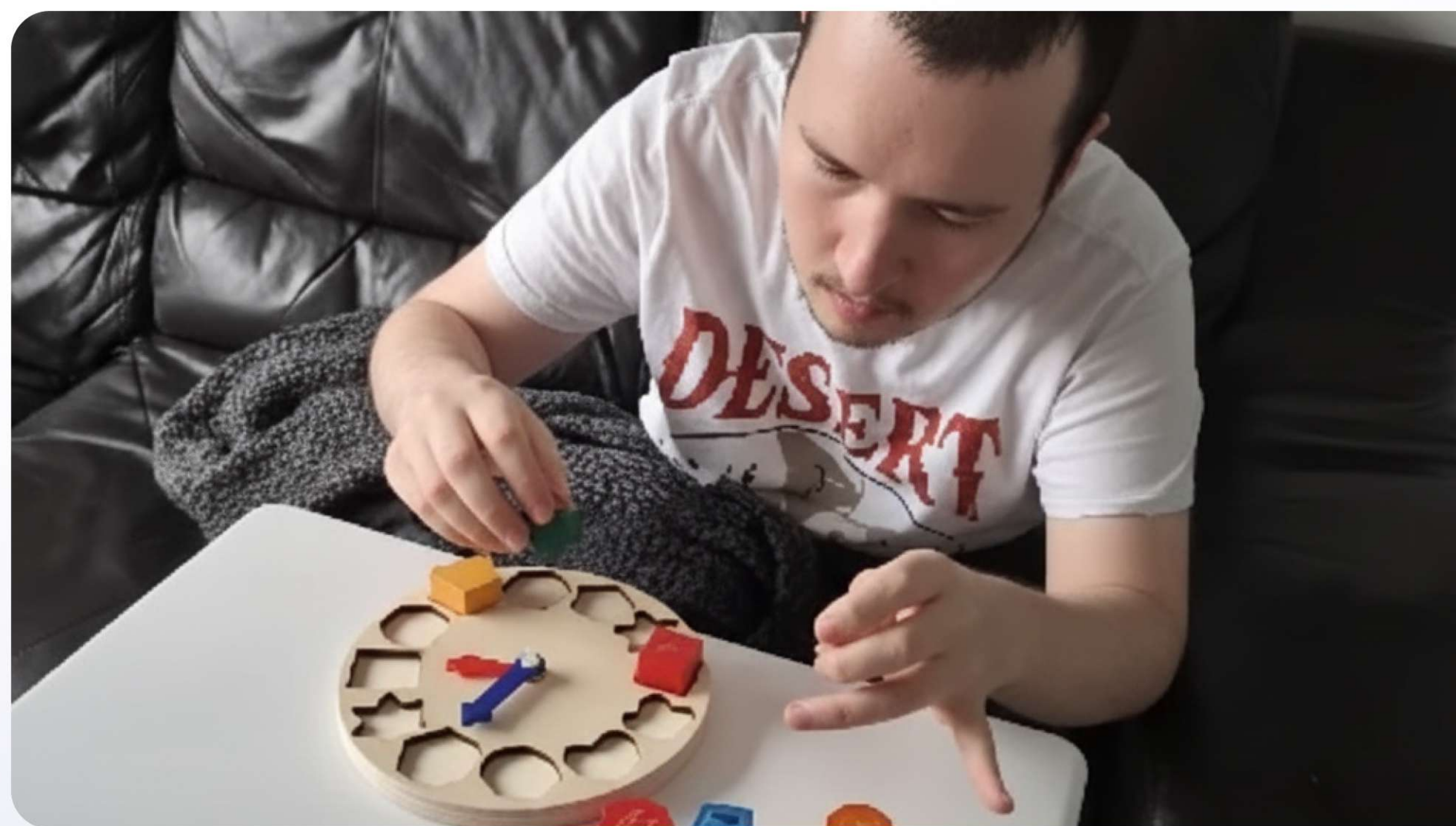


Life Skills Development

Calming sensory activities, quiet corners, soft music, and one-to-one time supported comfort and grounding throughout the month.

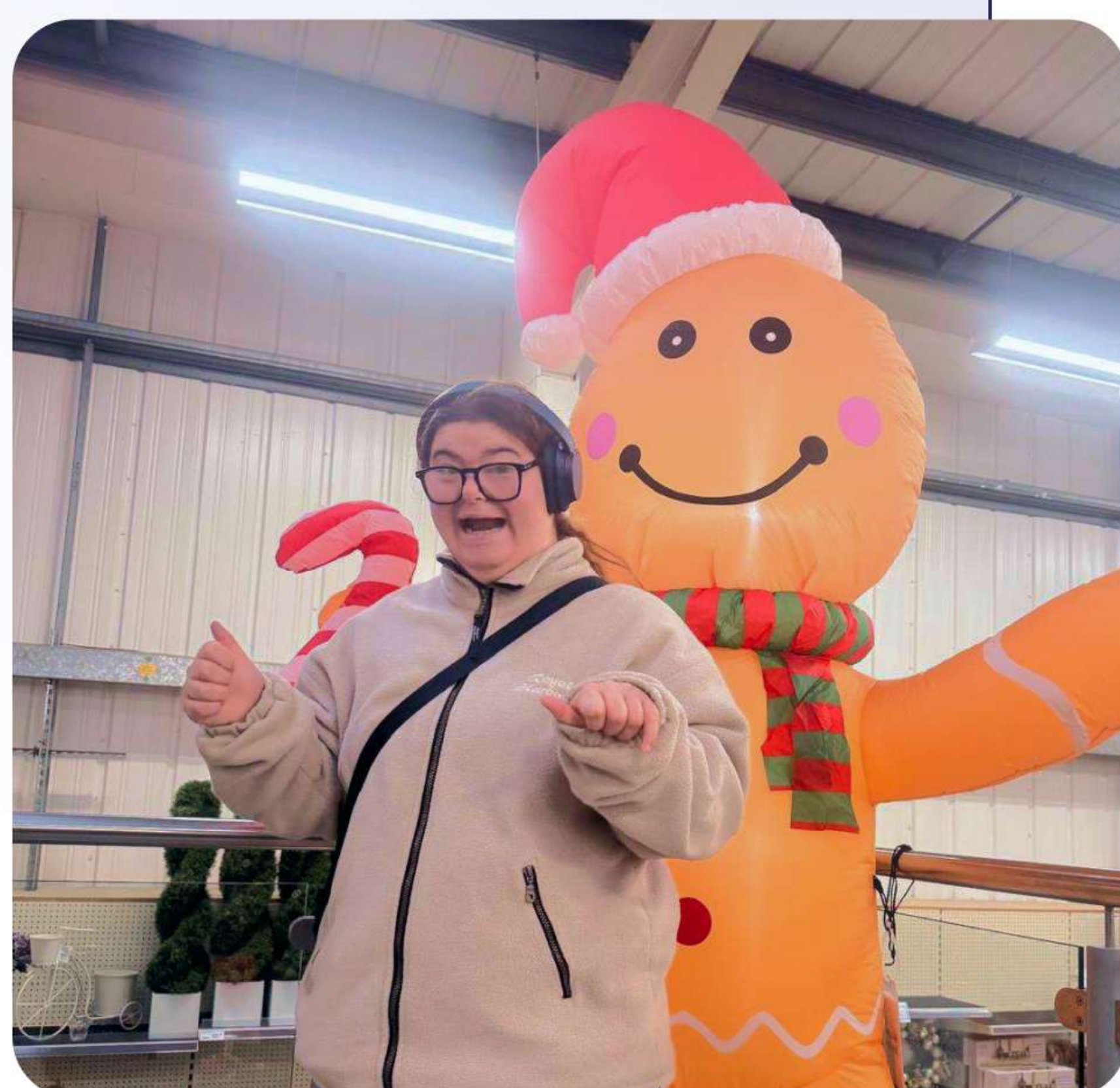
